The lifestyle of the people are very traditional and resemblance to that of the ancient times. This hidden rice land valley is famous for the temples in the Three Sisters Mountains. The watchtower to prevent the invasion of the Tibetans in ancient times still can be seen around the Phobjikha. The hiking of the Taktshang Goenba in Paro is another exciting activity to do in Paro. The world famous Tiger's Nest Monastery is the identity symbol of Bhutan. The monastery is vertically placed above 2000 ft from the floor of the valley.
